Parent Forum Autumn 24/11/20

- DN discussed review points from previous Parent Forum
- LS explained she felt routines were working well, homework was better online and emails are an effective use of communication for both parents and children and teachers have been quick to respond
- LS felt her children were now more confident to share any concerns through email
- LS felt communication when shutting down a bubble was generally good
- Drop off and pick-ups were discussed and LS felt they were organised and all children were very settled coming into school
- KL (by email) said that it was sometimes difficult to respond to homework and home learning electronically, and that when working from home it can be difficult to support children.
